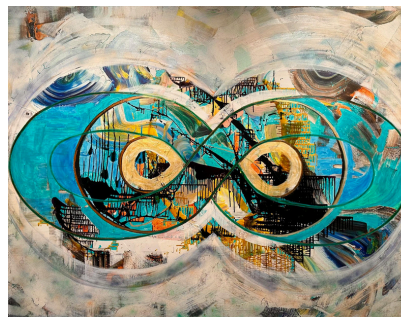

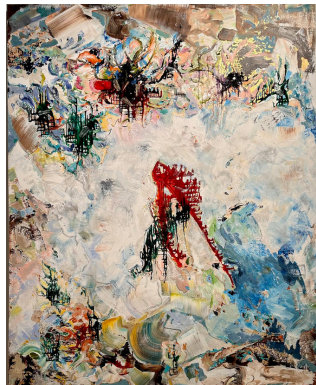

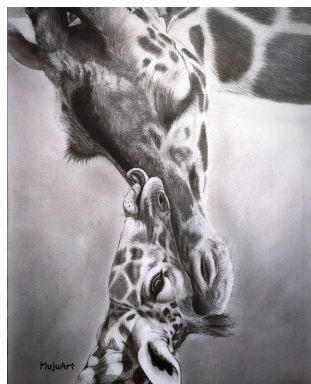
### Florah Maphosa

## Pharoah Mudenha

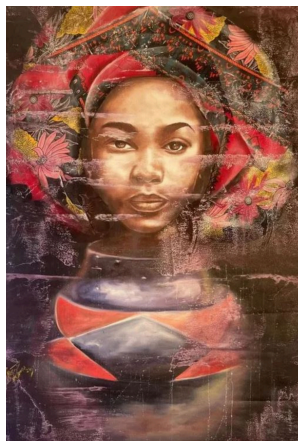
An emerging artist whose works capture the essence of Zimbabwean culture and everyday life.
